Bulgarian Association of Taekwon-Do has been approved for accreditation under the Erasmus+ Programme until 2027. A total of 240 young people will participate in the youth exchanges and trainings. 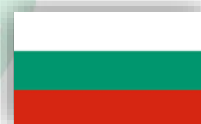

About Obzor



The town of Obzor is situated at the border between the areas of Burgas and Varna. It is situated in a gulf, starting north of the cape St. Atanas and reaches the Emin mountain. The Obzor resort is located at the scenic road, connecting the southern and northern seacoast.

Obzor offers various entertainment options – discos, bars, restaurants, pubs, attractive facilities, slides and pools at the hotel complexes.

Obzor is one of the most ancient settlements at the seashore. The numerous architectural and ceramic fragments, which were discovered attest to its rich millennium-old history. The first settlement in the area was Thracian and its name was Navlohos. The Greeks founded here Heliopolis (Sunny Town) in the 1st century BC. Later, the summer residence of the Byzantine emperors was built in the same lands. The Romans built here a temple of Jupiter. Later, the Bulgarians built here the Kozyak fortress. The ruins can be seen nowadays in Kaleto area. During the Ottoman Dominion, the village Gyozeken was built in these lands and since 1936 the town has been called Obzor.

The beach of the resort is about 10 kilometers long and 20 to 60 meters wide. The sand is grained and golden-colored.

- free Wi-Fi.

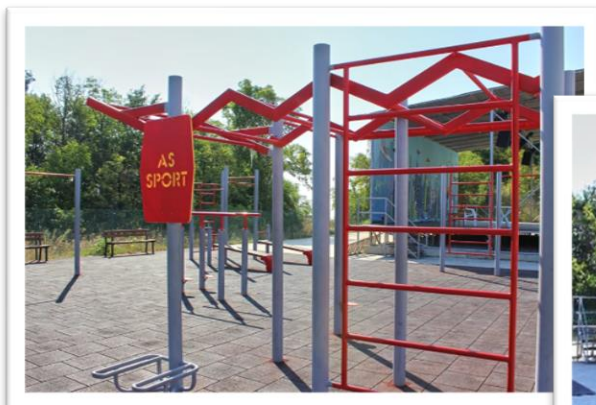


Sport infrastructure:

- Stage (8m x 12m; 3,85m height).

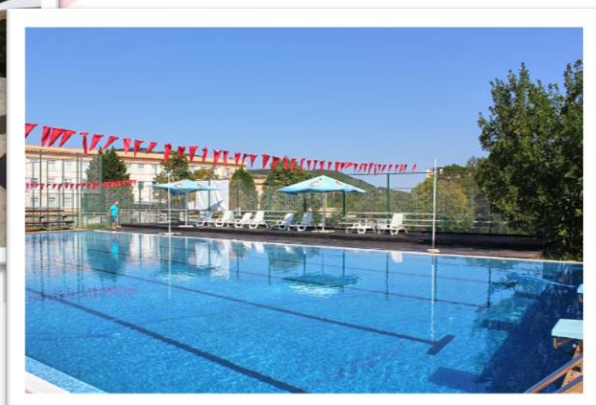
